Agreed that when students reported being assaulted, their peers didn't believe them



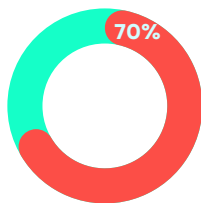

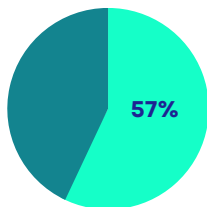
Agreed their school didn't adequately teach them where/how to report sexual violence
